SCCC Board Meeting Monday August 1st 2022

Meeting opened at 4:35 pm

Moment of silence

Present: Veda, Alice, Mary Jo, Loraine, Dave.

We have a quorum.

Guests: Robin Reeves, Amy- Veda's daughter and Joy Carafo.

Treasury report: Alice, the report handout is up to June, with an additional \$495.00 for desserts sold at the July 4th Fireworks and \$210.76 from the school reunion, {Donations less cost of foods purchased}.

Maintenance: Alice brought up the matter of Wifi in the building. The grant paid for the internet to be installed, equipment and labor, but additional access points are needed. Alice wanted to get a quote from Skyrunner to extend the access to the rest of the campus. Alice proposed a motion and Loraine seconded; all in favor. Alice will go forward with this project. Note: while discussion going on, Joy downloaded something, using the center's internet, and was very impressed with the speed.

Alice brought up the need for electricity in the utility room in Ph3. The roof is now repaired. Mary Jo asked if we could get a quote. We felt a small project like this is difficult to find an electrician. Alice is going to ask someone she knows to take a look.

Sheriff's office; it was suggested that we use the room to offer to the community a space, with a desk and chair, and good internet. Mary Jo proposed a motion and Veda seconded, all in favor.

Grants: Alice spoke about the Golden Leaf Foundation's grant. There is a need to hire architects to finalize plans and the quote came in at approx. \$64,000.00. The county requires a bid process (10 days). Veda spoke about the need for a volunteer work day, hire a dumpster, perhaps led by Coty and Shawn. Veda will talk to them about it. Simple work like nail pulling would save money in the long run, before the builders begin.

CPR/AED classes by SCVFD ongoing. Next one booked September 3rd, 4 ½ hours. Taught by Rob Putterman. More classes may develop, perhaps evening classes too.

Events: 4th of July went very well. Dave wants to keep it simple going forward with little advertising. It is a large event and we are all concerned about the safety of the community.

School reunion: discussion tabled until Linda is present.

Blood Drive on Saturday August 27th at the gym. Food and drink to be offered. Melissa Seip organizing with The Blood Connection. Alice will help with volunteers.
